Call for Papers:

A special issue of Social Neuroscience, guest-edited by Tatia Lee, PhD (Laboratory of Neuropsychology – The University of Hong Kong) and James Blair, PhD (NIMH), scheduled to appear in 2012, will feature original empirical articles that integrate neuroscientific approaches to the study of aggression and violence. Topics of interest include, for example, the social cognitive neuroscience of aggression and violence (studies examining typical processing in adult participants), developmental approaches to aggression and neuroscience, studies in clinical populations at risk for elevated levels of aggression and violence as well as systems and molecular neuroscience work in humans and animals.

Manuscript submission

Please submit an electronic copy of your manuscript through our online submissions website <http://mc.manuscriptcentral.com/psns> selecting 'Aggression and Violence' as the manuscript type. Your submission should be a single .doc or .pdf file and include a cover letter clearly indicating that your submission is to be considered for the special issue and explaining why the manuscript is well suited to this issue. Please also include a list of up to six suggested referees. The manuscript should be prepared in accordance with the usual guidelines of Social Neuroscience. Social Neuroscience articles have a maximum limit of 9000 words. This 9000 words is to include main text and references, but excludes title, author's contact details, abstract, figures, tables, captions and footnotes.
